damaged or buried under debris. Helped by Cpl BAPTIST he rallied the Pl and organised the fire posns and treatment of the wounded. As recon as the posn in the house had been restored he again

crossed the open yard with one Rfn to occupy an outside post, from which he engaged the ememy until they withdrew. relieving force and arrived, Cpl QUILL completed the re-organisation

of of his Pl and stayed at his post writil ordered back to the RAP by an officer, when the full severity of his wound was ansovered. This NCO's fighting spirit and self sacrifice were a magnificent

example to his Pl. His courage and initiative saved a very ugly situation.
